Notice Regarding Dividends from Retained Earnings

Tokyo, April 11, 2025 — IDOM Inc. (“the Company”) hereby announces that, at a meeting of the Board of Directors held on April 11, 2025, it resolved to make the payment of a dividend of surplus with February 28, 2025, as the record date. Details are as below. The subject matter will be submitted to the 31th Ordinary General Meeting of Shareholders to be held on May 27, 2025.

1. Details of dividends

2. Reason

The Company's policy on dividends is to pay performance-based dividends under which the Company will decide on dividends based on consolidated results. In principle, the Company uses 30% of profit attributable to owners of parent in the current fiscal year as total dividends for the determination of dividends per share for the current fiscal year. Based on this policy, the Company will pay a year-end dividend of 20.80 yen per share.
